Beliefs

MESC believes there is a direct correlation between the time provided for instruction and student learning.

Procedures

- 1. The school day must be structured to ensure that students are provided access to instruction consistent with the requirements of Alberta Education and the MESC.
- 2. The length of day may vary from school to school as dictated by busing.
- 3. The major responsibility for the structure of the school day will fall on the Principal and teaching staff in each school.
- 4. Principals will submit their daily schedule to the Associate Superintendent: Learning Services by June 15 of each year and shall make note on any changes.
- 5. All arrangements will require the approval of the Superintendent.
- 6. Teachers' timetables shall accurately reflect the daily schedule.
