 - 2. MESC curriculum will come first in MESC schools.

 - 4. Recommendation to include international treaties, numbered treaties and modern treaties.
 - 5. MESC's goal is to have fluent Cree in all schools. An immersion program would take at least 2 years to develop.
 - 6. Over 279 people have registered for online evening Cree classes.
 - 7. Cree language has been prioritized and instructors will be supported.
