 - 2. Students who receive a certificate of completion qualify for the scholarships as long as course marks meet requirements.
 - 3. The August 30th deadline allows for assessment throughout the school year and any students attending summer school.
 - 4. Consider naming scholarships in honor of Maskwacisak.
 - 5. Change requirement of 1500 word essay to provide a word essay up to 500 words.
 - 6. Individuals can donate funds for personalized scholarships.
- ii. Review staff bursaries policy
 - 1. Staff bursaries procedures will need to begin this year.
 - 2. Clarification on priority positions.
- iii. Suggestion to hire casual support staff throughout the summer for sports programming.
- iv. Table item. Have finance and audit committee review the following before the September board meeting:
 - 1. Potentially naming awards.
 - 2. Continuing education to post secondary.
 - 3. Reducing or eliminating essays.
 - 4. Clarification on academic scholarship vs grade 12 completion incentives.
