



Maskwacis Education Schools Commission

The Maskwacis Education Schools Commission (MESC) is the school authority in Maskwacis, Alberta. Its 11 schools serve approximately 2200 students from Ermineskin Cree Nation, Louis Bull Tribe, Montana First Nation and Samson Cree Nation.

MESC schools offer a strong balance between local Nehiyaw (Cree) core values according to the Maskwacis Declaration on Education and provincial academics as outlined in Alberta Education Programs of Study.

Maskwacis is located between Wetaskiwin and Ponoka on Highway 2A, approximately 60 minutes south of Edmonton and 60 minutes north of Red Deer. 10 of the 11 schools are located in Maskwacis proper, with one school located at Mameo Beach near Pigeon Lake, Alberta.
